

Non-evaluative Grade Option for Continuing Education Courses

Continuing Education students have the option to take courses with a letter grade or on a non-evaluative (NE) basis. When taken on an NE basis, students will not be evaluated for the work completed in the course. Restrictions related to the non-evaluative option are described below. Once this option is selected, it cannot be revoked. Please submit the form to your academic program director.

Non-Evaluative Grade Option Policies:

- · Courses used to fulfill the requirements for a certificate must be graded.
- · All non-evaluative decisions are irrevocable and will be recorded on the transcript as NE.
- · Approval to select the non-evaluative option must be submitted to the academic department within the first week of classes.
- · The student is responsible for adhering to these regulations.
